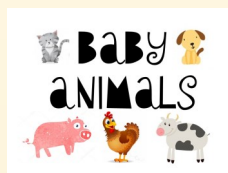
### DECADES DISPLAY and REGISTRATION DESK

Learn the game of elastics... England, Ireland, Scotland, Wales, Inside, Outside, On!



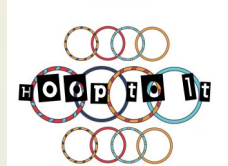
Get your face painted in your favourite design.

Learn to play hop scotch with our volunteers.



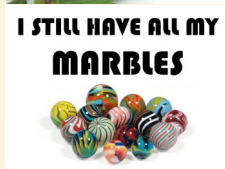
Try using an ink pen in our olden days school room. Pick up a copy book and give it a go!



Learn how to play the game of jacks.



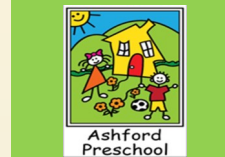
See how Johnny Cakes are cooked over hot coals and try one with golden syrup.

Let our volunteers show you how to do quilling.



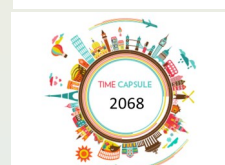
Test your skill. Land all the quoits and win a prize.
